

East Central Minnesota PFLAG Scholarship Application 2023/2024

East Central Minnesota PFLAG (Parents, Families and Friends of Lesbians and Gays) is an all-volunteer organization that provides support for gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender, questioning persons (and those who are perceived to be), their families and friends by being a visible presence in communities across the five-county region of east central Minnesota.

We share the mission of PFLAG chapters across Minnesota, as well as the rest of the country: *To promote the health and well-being of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender persons, their families and friends through:* <u>support,</u> to cope with an adverse society; <u>education,</u> to enlighten an ill-informed public; and <u>advocacy</u>, to end discrimination and secure equal rights. PFLAG provides opportunity for <u>dialogue</u> about sexual orientation, and acts to create a society that is healthy and respectful of human diversity. The goal of our scholarship program is to recognize and support LGBTQ+ youth, and to encourage LGBTQ+ students to continue on to postsecondary education. We believe that our young people who have succeeded in overcoming the many challenges they've faced will continue to do so throughout their lives.

Our scholarship program awards \$500 scholarships to LGBTQ+ seniors enrolled at high schools located within the five-county region of east central Minnesota (Kanabec, Isanti, Chisago, Pine, Mille Lacs). We also award \$500 scholarships to a first-year LGBTQ+ student enrolled at either Pine Technical and Community College or Anoka Ramsey Community College (Cambridge Campus).

This Year's deadline is April 15, 2024.

PFLAG SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- High school senior at one of the participating high schools
- First-year student enrolled in an area community college
- Making satisfactory academic progress
- Self identifies as LGBTQ+
- Will be enrolled in a post-secondary institution the following fall

Awarding of all scholarships will be based upon the following criteria:

- 1. Completion of the application form
- 2. A well-written application essay
- 3. A strong Letter of Recommendation

- Two page maximum application essay
- One (1) Signed Letter of Recommendation
- A copy of a current unofficial transcript, or other evidence of GPA and class standing

The following essay question must be answered in your own words and typed in English with minimal spelling or grammatical errors. The essay can be no longer than two pages, double-spaced.

Please address all of the following in your essay:

1. Based on your unique life experience, tell us about the challenges you've faced and/or the obstacles you've overcome as a young person who identifies as LGBTQ+.
