

### **Scholarship Program 2024**

#### The Award

Alexis Ann Hasser was just 18 years old when she lost her life following an automobile accident on March 10, 2018. Alexis was a senior at Braham Area High School, just months away from graduation. She loved playing sports, especially basketball. Alexis was a friend to everyone, she was not only beautiful on the outside but also on the inside. She had an infectious smile and a contagious laugh. She was a beautiful soul who touched the lives of so many people around her. In 2018, a group of family and friends created this memorial scholarship. An award of \$1,000 will be made to a deserving area high school student this May who will be attending college or university this Fall. The award will be provided to the student's school at the beginning of the Spring semester 2025. We will follow the same award process each year, with another \$1,000 awarded annually

#### **Eligibility**

The applicant must be a High School student graduating during the 2023/2024 school year and meet all the following criteria:

- The member must be a college bound high school senior at the time of application from one of the following school districts of Minnesota: Aitkin, Braham, Cambridge Isanti, East Central, Hinckley, Isle, Milaca, Mora, North Branch, Ogilvie, Onamia, Pine City, or Rush City.
- The applicant will be attending college for the first time in the fall of 2024.
- The applicant will be enrolled in either a two or four-year accredited educational institution.
- The applicant should be studying either a Social Work or Psychology major
- The applicant agrees to use any scholarship funds awarded for tuition and/or fees only.

To apply, eligible Seniors must complete this scholarship application form. Applicants should type or print clearly and use only the space provided on this form to answer the questions. Other than specified below, no attachments, resumes, pictures or other material of any kind should be used to answer the questions or should be submitted.
